The Three Pillars of Lent:

Pray is love for God.

Fast is love for yourself.

Give alms is love for others.



Pray: Lent is a great time to get closer to God - by praising Him, and praying with a special focus on repentance for our sins. Let us spend more time with God: set aside extra time for prayer (during our break at work or school), go to mass during the week aside from Sundays, visit in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, attend the Stations of the Cross (Fridays at 6:15 pm), and read scriptures such as in the Daily Reflections Booklet for Lent and Easter found at all entrances to our church.

The priest reminds us when we receive the ashes: "Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return." Or, "Turn away from sin, and be faithful to the Gospel."

Jesus told his disciples, "When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, who love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on street corners so that others may see them". (Matthew 6:5)

Pope Francis tells us to do away with our "funeral faces" and make room for joy as we are redeemed. Lent is a season of repentance, redemption and renewal. Have a good-filled season of Lent!
