


## Parish News

**From Father Mark:** Thank you for your prudent driving in the parking lot! Last week I informed you that we can open the Parish for more people to attend mass on the weekends. For the past couple of weeks, we continued to have 50 people reserved and can let walk-ups come to Mass. Starting this weekend we will have reservations up to 65 and will allow for a few walk ups to a maximum of 75 people to come to Mass. Going forward, I expect that people would continue to respect physical distance between individuals and between households continues.

However, the changes do NOT apply to social gatherings, weddings and funerals with a maximum of 50 people, again including the priest presider, lectors and music ministry. As I said last week "This is the new normal for us, BUT not the last word!"

Father Moise and I are constantly amazed with the visits on Sunday afternoons for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and many come to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation from 1pm-3pm. This continues to guide our faith and piety leading our prayers to move mountains!
